Bill would mandate insurance coverage of wigs

LANSENG — Although Wigs 4 Kids provides wigs and other services, free of charge, to children who lose their hair because of a medical issue or through treatment for a medical issue, there are so many more children in need of wigs than are cared for by the St. Clair Shores-based charity and salon.

"Everybody can't get access," said Wigs 4 Kids founder and CEO Maggie Varney. "Some of our kids and families that want to come here, we have to send them gas cards so they can come here and pick up a wig for free."
